SPEEDING IN RURAL VILLAGES

Mark has encouraged the shared purchase, by co-operating Parish Councils, of SAM2 signs to combat speeding in rural villages. These signs record the time and speed at which vehicles pass and can identify problem areas for the Police to enforce. Twelve of his villages now have access to SAM2 signs.

PROVISION OF SAFE WALKING ROUTES WITHIN VILLAGES

Mark has promoted the County Council's Parish Partnership scheme to the parishes in his Division. This has led to some parishes installing gravel trods on grass verges in villages where provision of a pavement would be prohibitively expensive, providing an even surface to walk on off the highway.

REDUCING SPEED LIMITS

Mark was asked to investigate the possibility of reducing the 60mph limit on the A1065 through Weasenham. He requested County Highways to survey the road. The results identified several potential hazards and showed that a speed reduction was justified. A 50mph limit has now been introduced.
